The Two Ways of Knowing Your Creator

The first is by observing His creation.

Allah says in the Quran –

إِنَّ فِي خَلْقِ السَّمَاوَاتِ وَالأَرْضِ وَاخْتِلاَفِ اللَّيْلِ وَالنَّهَارِ وَالْفُلْكِ الَّتِي تَجْرِي فِي الْبَحْرِ بِمَا يَنفَعُ النَّاسَ وَمَا أَنزَلَ اللَّهُ مِنَ السَّمَاء مِن مَّاء فَأَخْيَا بِهِ الأرْضَ بَعْدَ مَوْتِهَا وَبَثَّ فِيهَا مِن كُلِّ دَآبَّةٍ وَتَصْرِيفِ الرِّيَاحِ وَالسَّحَابِ الْمُسَخِّرِ بَيْنَ السَّمَاء وَالأَرْضِ لآيَاتٍ

Verily! In the creation of the heavens and the earth, and in the alternation of night and day, and the ships which sail through the sea with that which is of use to mankind, and the water (rain) which <u>Allah</u> sends down from the sky and makes the earth alive therewith after its death, and the moving (living) creatures of all kinds that He has scattered therein, and in the veering of winds and clouds which are held between the sky and the earth, are indeed Ayat (proofs, evidences, signs, etc.) for people of understanding. [Quran – Al-Bagara 2:164]

The Quran also states:

إِنَّ فِي خَلْقِ السَّمَاوَاتِ وَالأَرْضِ وَاخْتِلاَفِ اللَّيْلِ وَالنَّهَارِ لآيَاتٍ لِّأُوْلِي الأَلْبَابِ الَّذِينَ يَذْكُرُونَ الله قِيَامًا وَقُعُودًا وَعَلَىَ جُنُوبِهِمْ وَيَتَفَكَّرُونَ فِي خَلْقِ السَّمَاوَاتِ وَالأَرْضِ رَبَّنَا مَا خَلَقْتَ هَذا بَاطِلاً سُبْحَانَكَ فَقِنَا عَذَابَ النَّارِ Surely in the creation of the heavens and the earth, and in the alternation of night and day, there are signs for men of understanding.

Those who remember Allah (always, and in <u>prayers</u>) standing, sitting, and lying down on their sides, and think deeply about the creation of the heavens and the earth, (saying): "Our Lord! You have not created (all) this without purpose, glory to You! (Exalted be You above all that they associate with You as partners). Give us salvation from the torment of the Fire. [Quran – <u>Al-Ímran</u> 3:190]

The second way of knowing Allah is to ponder over the verses of the <u>Quran</u>.

The Quran states:

كِتَابٌ أَنزَنْنَاهُ إِلَيْكَ مُبَارَكٌ لِّيَدَّبَّرُوا آيَاتِهِ وَلِيَتَذَكَّرَ أُوْلُوا الْأَلْبَاب

(This is) a Book (the Quran) which We have sent down to you, full of blessings that they may ponder over its Verses, and that men of understanding may remember. [Quran – <u>Saad</u> 38:29]



Knowing these two ways should drive us to take the necessary steps to prioritize our lives properly. Many of us commonly fall into the trap of putting Allah's remembrance and Quran recitation and <u>reflection</u> at the bottom of our lists. Instead, we should recognize that sometimes, rather than just needing <u>more</u> time, wealth, resources, etc. in our lives, we need more of <u>Allah's blessings</u> and 'barakah' in what we already have. With no such blessings, we can't expect to achieve <u>success</u> and happiness. Instead of chasing life's never-ending pursuits, let's be with Allah and His book. In return, we will achieve the best of this life and the hereafter and our affairs will become more manageable.
