Committing Shirk in the name of Waseela (intercession):

It is common practice in present day society that people are committing Shirk under the disguise of waseela (Intercession) of some pious people either alive or dead. They go to their graves and Say these saints/Wali Allah were pious people, Allah love them, so they can intercede to Allah on their behalf. For people who are alive, they have same contention that they are pious people and have direct connection with Allah (SWT) and they can intercede for them. Interestingly these all claim that Allah is supreme creator of everything in Heaven and Earth, Nothing happens without His Knowledge and permission, but they think that these pious people are beloved to Allah, so they can persuade Him for such and such things in their favors. Some also believe that though Allah is Supreme, but He Needs some deputies, assistants to run His affairs of the world and these pious, Saints acts as His assistants. Some even say that when they go to graves sights of these saints, they do not ask them any of their needs but simply these places and their surrounding are so blessed that their supplications/Duas are accepted by Allah (SWT) etc.

Incidentally same kind of thinking Mushrakeen (Polytheists) of Arab had in the time of Jahalia (Era of ignorance) before the advent of and in the time of Prophet Muhammad (SAW). They all believed in Allah being supreme, creator of the universe and unlimited power and authority, but He needs assistance, or listens to His pious people and that's why they ask them to intercede to Allah on their behalf.

This kind of thinking in the sight of Allah (SWT) and Quran is pure and major Shirk.

Here are few References from Quran in this regard>

They worship other deities besides Allah, who can neither harm them nor benefit them, and they say: "These are our intercessor with Allah."O Muhammad, say to them: Are you informing Allah of what He knows to exist neither in the heavens nor on the earth? Glory to Him! He is far above from having the partners they ascribe to Him!" Q 10/18

Or have they chosen intercessors other than God? Say, "Even though they have no power over anything, and are devoid of reason?"

Say, "All intercession is up to God. To Him belongs the kingdom of the heavens and the earth. Then to Him you will be returned. Q 39/43

Is not to God that sincere faith is due? As for those who take guardians besides Him, "We only worship them that they may bring us nearer to Allah." Allah will judge between them regarding their differences. God does not guide the lying and ungrateful. Q39/2

[Allah calls Mushriks Liars and ungrateful, because they tell lie that these pious and saint people are Allah's beloved so they ask them to intercede on their behalf and they are ungrateful that they enjoy all their life due to Allah's Mercy but thanks other.]

5)

Say, "Call upon those you claim besides Him. They have no power to relieve your adversity, nor can they change it."

Those they call upon are themselves seeking means of access to their Lord, vying to be nearer, and hoping for His mercy, and fearing His punishment. The punishment of your Lord is to be dreaded. Q17/56-57.

6)

They have taken their rabbis and their priests as lords instead of Allah, as well as the Messiah son of Mary. Although they were commanded to worship none but The One Allah. There is no god except He. Glory be to Him; High above what they associate with Him. Q9/31

On the Day when He gathers them, and what they worshiped besides God, He will say, "Was it you who misled these servants of Mine, or was it they who lost the way?"

They will say, "Glory be to You. It was not for us to take any lords besides You. But you gave them enjoyments, and their ancestors, until they forgot the Message, and became ruined people." Q25/17-18

Who is more wrong than him who invokes, besides God, those who will not answer him until the Day of Resurrection, and are heedless of their prayers? Q46/5

And if you asked them, "Who created the heavens and the earth?" they would say, "Allah." Say, "Have you seen those you pray to instead of Allah? If Allah willed any harm for me, can they lift His harm? And if He willed a blessing for me, can they hold back His mercy?" Say, "Allah suffices for me. On Him the reliant rely. Q39/38.

11)

Those you call upon besides Allah ,slaves like you. So call upon them, and let them answer you, if you are truthful. Q7/194

12)

Those you call upon besides Him cannot help you, nor can they help themselves. Q7/197.

13)

The Messiah son of Mary was only a messenger, before whom other Messengers had passed away, and his mother was a woman of truth. They both used to eat food. Note how We make clear the revelations to them; then note how deluded they are.

. Say, "Do you worship, besides Allah, what has no power to harm or benefit you?" But Allah: He is the Hearer, the Knower. Q5/75/76.

A lot of people who use "Waseela" intercessor of pious and saints in asking Allah for their needs claim that Quran forbids only idols (Like Mushrakeen of Mecca or Hindus and other religion worships) to ask for help. But from above Ayats quoted above it is very obvious that Allah is not talking about Idols, stones or pictures of saints etc, He is talking about persons, like Prophets, saints, pious people.

Forget about pious persons or Saints, we cannot even ask Our beloved Prophet Muhammad (SAW) for help and his waseela in this world. Look what Quran says about Prophet Muhammad (SAW).

Say, "I do not say to you that I possess the treasuries of Allah, nor do I know the future, nor do I say to you that I am an angel. I only follow what is inspired to me." Say, "Are the blind and the seeing alike? Do you not think? Q6/50

Say, "I have no control over any benefit or harm to myself, except as Allh wills. Had I known the future, I would have acquired much good, and no harm would have touched me. I am only a warner, and a herald of good news to a people who believe."

It is obvious from above Ayats that Most beloved creation to Allah our beloved Prophet cannot help us if we ask his intercession in this world (It is true Our beloved Prophet will intercede for us on the Day of Judgment only with the permission of Allah, but the people committed shirk and died without repentance will not benefit at all with this intersession).

It is also important to mention that at the time of Prophet, when Prophet told the people how to do the Talbiyah (Recitation at the time of Hajj and umrah), Mushrakeen continued adding words to include people who they thought will help them in persuading Allah.

The difference in Talbiyah (the chant recited during Hajj and Umrah) between the Muslims and the polytheists (Mushrikeen) at the time of Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) is mentioned in Sahih al-Bukhari. The Mushrikun used to add polytheistic phrases to the Talbiyah, associating partners with Allah, while the Muslims recited a pure monotheistic

Talbiyah.

The Hadith from Sahih al-Bukhari (Book of Hajj)
Book 26, Hadith 667 explains:

The Muslims used to say: "Here I am, O Allah, here I am. There is no partner to You, here I am. Surely, all praise, grace, and sovereignty belong to You. There is no partner to You."

In contrast, the polytheists added phrases to the Talbiyah that implied shirk (associating partners with Allah).

They said: "Here I am, there is no partner to You, except a partner whom You own and all that he owns."

This addition by the polytheists reflected their belief in associating partners with Allah, which Islam came to reject entirely, emphasizing pure monotheism (Tawhid).

Also remember Allah Himself Says in Quran:

وَإِذَا سَأَلُكَ عِبَادِي عَنِّي فَإِنِّي قَرِيبٌ أُجِيبُ دَعْوَةَ الدَّاعِ إِذَا دَعَانِ فَلْيَسْتَجِيبُواْ لِي وَإِذَا سَأَلُكَ عِبَادِي عَنِّي فَإِنِّي قَرِيبُ أُجِيبُواْ لِي لَعَلَّهُمْ يَرْشُدُونَ وَلْيُؤْمِنُواْ بِي لَعَلَّهُمْ يَرْشُدُونَ

And when My servants ask you about Me, I Am near; I answer the call of the caller when he calls on Me. So let them answer Me, and have faith in Me, that they may be rightly guided. Q2/186

So when Allah Hears what we ask and Answers our call then why we need any other person Waseela of intersession?

Bottom line is why people who believe in Allah are called Mushriks (polytheists), because they believed other human beings as their intercessors to Allah.

Remember at the time of prophet, his companions used to ask him to pray Allah for such and such things like for rain or stoppage of severe rain etc, This was perfectly ok, as they were asking him to pray to Allah, they were not saying please stop the rain as you are Allah's Messenger and beloved to Allah, so you have the authority to do such and such thing or you can intercede in Allah's affair. And after his death, you cannot go to his grave and ask for anything and request to intercede with Allah (SWT) for such and such thing, neither you can ask him to intercede for you after his departure from this world. Sending

salutation to him in his absence is different, because Allah conveys our salutation to him.

Similarly we can ask our fellow Muslims in their presence to pray Allah for you for such and such things like for health, finding a job or getting pious spouses etc. This is supported by Hadith "The supplication of a Muslim for his brother in his absence will certainly be answered. Every time he makes a supplication for good for his brother, the angel appointed for this particular task say: Ameen! May it be for you too" (Sahih Muslim, Hadith 2733).

Bottom Line: Dua (Supplication)

is only with Allah (SWT), directly not through any other person's or entity intercession, Period!, If someone does contrary to this, he is committing Shirk!
